EVALUATION POLICY

Classes I to V:

A continuous assessment scheme is followed from classes I - V. There would be two periodic tests for classes 1 – V in each term. The student is graded regularly and evaluation is based on the child's participation and performance in class activities, homework, group work, worksheets, class assessment, class response, reading and communications skills, morning assembly, individual and group behaviour. Classes I – V will be awarded grades as well as marks.

Classes VI to VIII:

Academic session for classes VI – VIII is divided into two terms. One cycle of Unit Test will be conducted before Half Yearly Examinations and the second cycle will be conducted before Annual Examination.

Classes IX and X:

For classes IX and X examination pattern is strictly as per CBSE guidelines. For class IX students, three periodic written tests and a Term Exam (Annual Examination) are conducted in the academic session. The syllabus and the marks distribution are as per the CBSE guidelines.

For class X students, three periodic tests and Pre-Board Examinations are conducted in the academic session followed by CBSE Board Examination.

Classes IX and XII:

In class XI, students can opt for the Science or Commerce or Humanities streams, which enables them to appear for the All India Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by the CBSE.

For Class XI students, one Unit Test and Term Exam (Half Yearly Exam) are conducted in the first term and two Unit Tests and Term Exam (Annual Exam) are conducted in the second term.

For Class XII students, one Unit Test and three Examinations are conducted in the entire academic session followed by CBSE Board Examination.

PROMOTION POLICY

Classes VI – VIII:

Term-I: 80 marks of Half Yearly Exam + 10 marks Periodic Test-I + 5 marks Notebook + 5 marks Subject Enrichment Activities.

Term-II: 80 marks of Annual Exam + 10 marks Periodic Test-II + 5 marks Notebook + 5 marks Subject Enrichment Activities.

Weightage for promotional result:

First Term – 50% + Second Term – 50%

Class IX:

80 marks of Annual Exam + 5 marks Pen Paper Test + 5 marks Multiple Assessment + 5 Portfolio + 5 marks Subject Enrichment Activities.

Class X:

80 marks of CBSE Board Examination + 5 marks Pen Paper Test + 5 marks Multiple Assessment + 5 Portfolio + 5 marks Subject Enrichment Activities.
