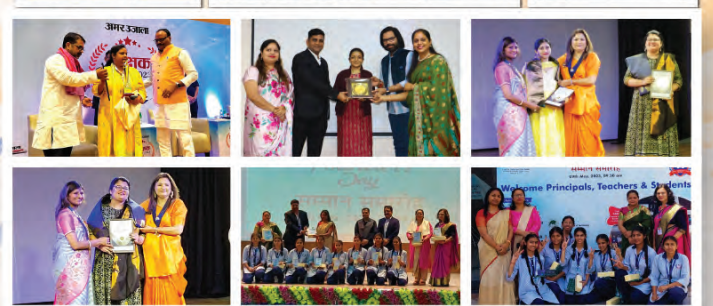

Facilities

MBIC believes that students should become global citizens while retraining their traditional values. Keeping this in mind, all the important national days and festivals are celebrated through special assemblies.



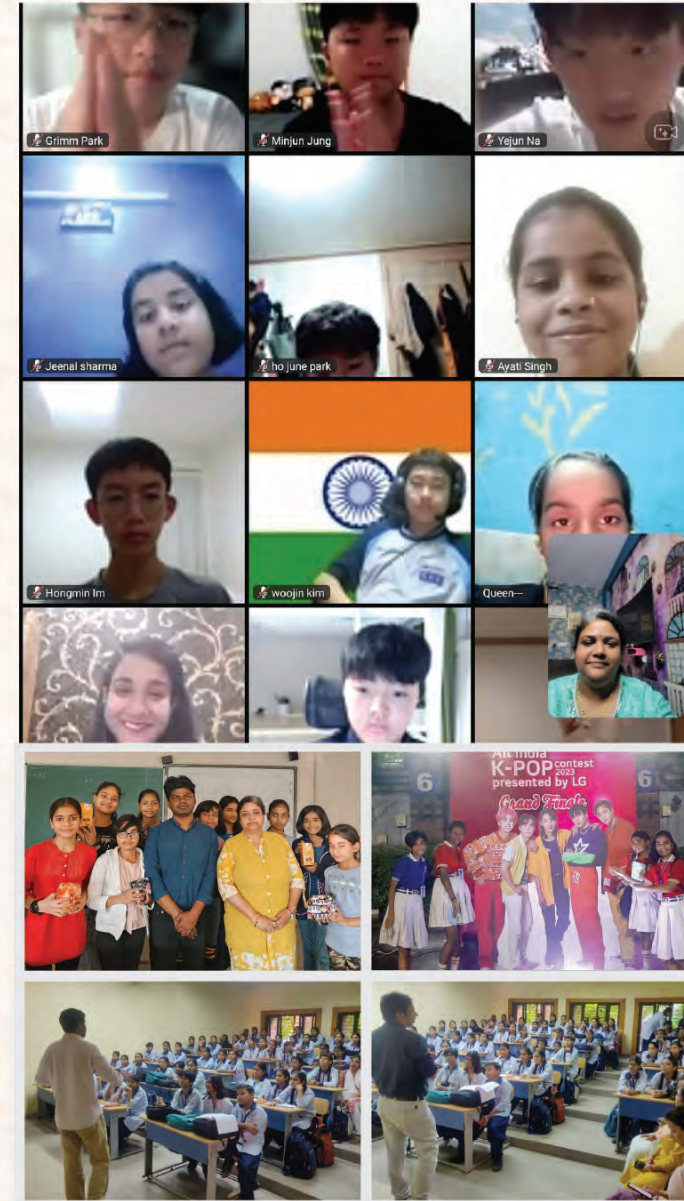
Co-Curricular Activities
